Over the course of the COVID-19 pandemic, Circle Health Urgent Care has followed directives from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, the American College of Occupational and Environmental Medicine (ACOEM) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

On March 15, 2020, on the guidance of ACOEM, we made the decision to suspend some of our services to help minimize the potential spread of the COVID-19 virus. These services include breath alcohol testing and pulmonary testing.

Circle Health has moved forward in accordance with the Baker-Polito Administration's Reopening Massachusetts Guidelines to bring back services at both our hospital campuses and outpatient settings in a phased approach. This phased approach is based on hospital capacity and current state directives to manage the second surge of COVID-19 cases in our communities. We are working with our infectious disease physicians and our infection control and prevention experts to finalize safe protocols to resume breath alcohol and pulmonary testing to help our clients stay in compliance with FMCSA regulations.

We will continue to keep you informed as we continue to reactivate our programs and services, and appreciate your patience and support during these challenging times.
